

Descriptions and Requirements for Classes

Youth Art - Children who desire to learn all the different mediums in the art world

Teen Art - Older students who desire to have a more intensive class in art

Exploring Art - For young children who are just learning art.

Adult Art - A relaxed environment for adults to enjoy the friendship and time of encouragement together

Minuet Strings - Young children who are just learning to play a string instrument

Allegro Strings - Older students who have some experience in strings. Just learning the basics of playing in a group.

Sonata Strings - Students who are just learning 3 octave scales and are ready for more intense music. This group will become another traveling string group for events along with the Ebony strings group. Audition only.

Ebony Strings - Experienced string players. These players must know all of their 3 octave scales and can master more difficult string techniques including spiccato, double stops, as well as faster passages in tune. Audition only.

Emerald Strings - Advanced string players. These players should be familiar in all techniques. Audition only.

Choir 1 - Singers who do not feel comfortable singing acapella and would do best learning easier songs first.

Choir 2 - Singers who are learning the basics of singing multiple parts acapella.

Chorale - by audition only. Experienced singers who are able to sing many parts. Some choreography may be included.

Intensive rehearsals.

Guitar 1 - Students who are just beginning to learn playing the guitar. They will learn how to hold and tune their instruments, as well as learn simple chords and scales. Beginning to learn chords.

Guitar 2 - Ongoing learning for students who are learning to read music.

CASO - Creative Arts Symphony Orchestra - this is not a class. It is a community orchestra specifically created for students who are already in a strings class but desire to have the experience of a full orchestra sound. Adults who have had to set their instruments aside since high school can feel free to pull them out and join! Music is tailor-made for the ability of the students.

Robotics - Students learn the world of electronics and robotics.

Speech/Drama/Debate - Students learn to become confident when speaking or acting.

Theater - Created for students of CCA and their families to become part of CCA's annual fundraiser dinner theater.

Rehearsals begin with 1 Saturday per month for the Fall semester, and increase to 2 Saturdays in the Spring semester, gradually increasing as the event draws closer. Rehearsals are 4 hour long segments. Singers/Actors are required to study their music and lines between rehearsals.
